

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- There are various types of scholarships available, each receiving limited funding from different sources. Scholarships are awarded on a **first come, first served basis**, as funding becomes available.
- Any difference between scholarship funding and total cost must be paid **at the time of registration**.
- Applicants must be **residents of the City of Fremont** and may only apply for scholarships under one name, under a single household address.
- **Only one “customer requested” transfer is allowed per calendar year.**
- Applicants may apply for each of the scholarships listed below within a *calendar year* (Jan. 1 through Dec. 31) beginning with the dates specified. The scholarship types are as follows:

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP:

Beginning **January 1**, applicants may apply for one or more recreation classes not to exceed a maximum of **\$75.00** per year. Once total funding is exhausted for the year, scholarships will not be granted again until the beginning of the next fiscal year, **July 1**. *General Scholarship funds may **not** be applied toward the Summer Playcamp Program or Aqua Adventure Season Passes.*

ART SCHOLARSHIP:

As funds are available, applicants, ages 0-17, may apply for one (1) class, not to exceed a maximum of **\$75.00** per year for visual art classes (e.g. drawing, painting, ceramics, etc.).

WATERPARK SCHOLARSHIP:

Applicants may apply for up to four (4) individual one-day tickets per **qualifying household** (currently valued at \$17.99 each). If desired, scholarship recipients may take their ticket to the Waterpark Sales Office during regular operating hours, and pay the difference in order to purchase a **season pass**. *Tickets are not transferable and **may not be combined** toward the purchase of one season pass. Other scholarship funds may not be used toward the purchase of Waterpark tickets/passes.*

SUMMER PLAYCAMPS:

Up to 3 free weeks of camp for ages 6-11 at designated locations in Fremont. See annual flyer for details.

TEEN LEADERSHIP ACADEMY (Volunteer Program)

Partial scholarship for 1 session of YSC or CIT for participants entering grades 7th-12th. Teens can earn service learning hours by participating in YSC or CIT. Program runs mid-June thru mid-August. See annual flyer for details.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, applicants must submit a scholarship application form and a copy of **ONE** of the following documents, showing a **Fremont address** and **dated within 30 days of application**.

Additional documentation may be requested by the City.

- A. **School Lunch Assistance Program** – free or reduced school lunches from FUSD
- B. **PG&E Bill** – reflecting a CARE credit
- C. **General Assistance** – notice of action or copy of a check from County Social Services
- D. **CalWORKS** (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) (formerly AFDC) – notice of action, computer printout, or benefit letter.
