Less Energy, More Savings

LEDs will save the City \$590,000 on annual electric utility bills.



Less Energy, Cleaner Environment

LEDs will reduce the City's energy consumption by 4 million kilowatt-hours annually & lower greenhouse gas emissions by 775 metric tons.



Better Quality, Safer Streets

LEDs will provide better coverage, helping to eliminate dark areas & making our streets safer.



Longer Lasting, Less Maintenance

LEDs will last over 100,000 hours, resulting in fewer outages & reduced maintenance costs.

CITY UPGRADES

City facilities will also be upgraded with interior and exterior LED lighting, water-saving fixtures, and irrigation controls.
