

ENCROACHMENT PERMIT SUBMITTAL LIST

(TEMPORARY USE OR ACCESS OVER PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY) (REPAIR, REPLACEMENT & MINOR RELOCATION OF EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS)

DESCRIPTION: Temporary use, access over, or minor improvements within the public-right-of-way including:

- Storage of materials
- Installation, removal or inspection of monitoring wells
- Repair or replacement of existing improvements

- Placement of scaffolding
- Driving of trucks & equipment over curb, gutter & sidewalk
- Minor relocation of existing driveways or other improvements

		Traffic control plan – Submit a <u>Traffic Control Plan Application Form</u> and One (1) Copy of the Traffic Control Plan (Allow for a minimum of 10 business days for review)(only required if work is on an arterial street or near a school)
