

Overview of Recommended Animal Ordinance Amendments

The proposed animal ordinance amendments would:

- Permit ownership of two goats under certain circumstances
- Expand ownership of beehives under certain circumstances
- Clarify and update chicken ownership
- Make minor revisions to animal shelter, vaccination and leash requirements



Fremont Resident Input

City staff conducted a community meeting and solicited feedback via "My Fremont" the City's new community engagement platform.

Common themes included:

- Support for ordinance amendments that would allow residents to keep goats
- Support for ordinance amendments that would expand beehive ownership
- Questions regarding the City's proposed property line and square footage requirements for keeping certain types of animals
- Questions regarding how the City intends to enforce new and existing ordinances

Chicken Ordinance Summary

The enclosure where chickens are kept must be a minimum size of ten (10) square feet of permeable land per chicken. The enclosure where chickens are kept must be located at least a minimum distance away from any other person's property line, as follows:

1-6	10 feet	6,001-9,999	No
7-10	35 feet	10,000-21,779	Yes
11-15	50 feet	21,780 +	Yes
