

MINUTES FREMONT ZONING ADMINISTRATOR REGULAR MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 19, 2022

PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

Item 1. MY MOTHER'S HUG ZAP – 5130 Mowry Avenue – (PLN2022-00396) – To consider a Zoning Administrator Permit for the conversion of an existing warehouse and outdoor storage area into a child day care facility and outdoor play area, respectively; and to consider an exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per CEQA Guidelines §15183 (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan, General Plan, or Zoning), §15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures), and §15304 (Minor Alterations to Land). Each of the foregoing provides a separate and independent basis for CEQA compliance.

Associate Planner Mayank Patel introduced the item.

Zoning Administrator Clifford Nguyen opened the public hearing.

Sandeep M. (no last name given) is the owner of a large family daycare center located directly behind the proposed project. Sandeep expressed concern on how the proposed project may affect his business.

Zoning Administrator Clifford Nguyen asked clarifying questions to Staff and the applicant regarding drop-off and pick-up schedules, and the playground area.

FOUND THAT PLN2022-00396, A ZONING ADMINISTRATOR PERMIT FOR A CHILD DAY CARE FACILITY, IS IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE RELEVANT PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN THE CITY'S EXISTING GENERAL PLAN;

AND

APPROVED PLN2022-00396, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A," SUBJECT TO FINDINGS AND CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL IN EXHIBIT "B."

Item 1 was approved with the following additional condition of approval:

<u>Safety Measures</u>. The applicant shall work with Staff to incorporate additional (i.e., beyond the proposed fence) safety measures and/or design solutions to create a stronger separation between the proposed outdoor play area and the row of parking to the south, as depicted on Sheet A.1.1 of Exhibit A.
