Public preview, then public review, input, discussion, along with larger staff review, etc. (In Progress)


Our Core Values - Draft



Teaching and Learning

- Implement state-adopted instructional standards to support students in attaining high academic achievement and post-secondary success.
- Support a well-balanced, comprehensive educational program that values creativity, collaboration, critical thinking, citizenship, and communication.
- Implement a professional development model that ensures continued professional growth for staff to support the needs of all learners.
- Provide course offerings and career pathways to create greater diverse learning opportunities for students.
- Narrow the access and opportunity gaps through the implementation of local assessments, data-driven decisions, and tiered interventions.
- Leverage technology to enhance learning when appropriate with a focus on pedagogy.
- Utilize inclusion to support access to the core curriculum for all students.

Safe Supportive Schools

- Promote a safe school culture and learning environment that supports students' physical, mental, and emotional health with a focus on Social and Emotional Learning where all students are valued.
- Provide equitable access and opportunities for all families to build connections within the school community.
- Partner with parents, community members, and other stakeholders to support the success of students and the school community.
- Promote continuous growth and improvement for emergency preparedness and response.
- Promote effective and progressive practices to address student behavior in the earliest possible intervention points through programs such as PBIS and Restorative Justice practices.

Sound Fiscal Management

- Align district budget policies and resources to support the educational goals of the district.
- Ensure good stewardship of public resources to provide the maximum impact on student learning.
- Provide well-maintained and updated facilities to promote a positive and safe learning environment for all students and staff.
- Implement environmentally sound practices throughout the district.
- Allocate funds in alignment with FUSD goals in support of student learning.
