# Ceremonial Flag Display

JULY 11, 2023





## Background

December 20, 2022- Council directed staff to research and develop recommendations for ceremonial flag displays

January 10, 2023- Council discussed an additional flag related referral and reaffirmed request for staff recommendations regarding ceremonial flag displays

February 21, 2023- Council approved several procedural aspects of a ceremonial flag display procedure and directed staff to develop a ceremonial flag procedure that:

- (1) Allows Council to adopt an annual calendar of **five** Ceremonial Flag Displays
- (2) Includes a process to **schedule** different events
- (3) Establishes a **criteria** for selecting ceremonial flags for display



## Proposed Observance Selection Criteria

Staff researched options and recommends a ceremonial flag display selection criteria:

- Observance (or heritage month) is State of California and/or Federally recognized
- Observance is not explicitly related to a religious holiday or specific individual
- Observance is associated with a flag that can be acquired by the City to be displayed on the City's standard flagpole
- Observance's ceremonial flag can be displayed for no less than five days and no more than 31 days
- Observance is aligned with the City of Fremont's designation as a compassionate City and is supportive of the goals of diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Observance period will not overlap with conflicting observances in a single calendar year. If there is an overlap in the observance periods, the Council or City Manager will organize the calendar to alternate observances in successive years



## Scheduling Option #1- Rotation

This scheduling model would rotate five ceremonial flag observances each year and would advise staff of which five would be honored in each respective calendar year.

Proposed Ceremonial Flag Observance	Dates of Observance	Schedule for Observance
Black History Month	February 1- February 28	Odd Year Observance
Women's History Month	March 1- March 30	Odd Year Observance
Arab American Heritage Month	April 1- April 30	Even Year Observance
Asian American and Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander Heritage Month	May 1- May 31	Even Year Observance
Jewish American Heritage Month	May 1- May 31	Odd Year Observance
LGBTQ+ Pride Month	June 1- June 30	Odd Year Observance
Caribbean-American Heritage Month	June 1- June 30	Even Year Observance
Hispanic Heritage Month	September 15- October 15	Odd Year Observance
Disability Employment Awareness Month	October 1- October 31	Even Year Observance
Native American Heritage Month	November 1- November 30	Even Year Observance



# Scheduling Option #2- Partial Rotation

This scheduling model would include annual ceremonial flag observance of Black History Month and LGBTQ+ Pride Month while rotating observances through the remaining three authorized ceremonial flag observance months.

Black History Month	February 1- February 28	Annual Observance
Women's History Month	March 1- March 30	Biennial Rotation
Arab American Heritage Month	April 1- April 30	Biennial Rotation
Asian American and Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander Heritage Month	May 1- May 31	Biennial Rotation
Jewish American Heritage Month	May 1- May 31	Biennial Rotation
LGBTQ+ Pride Month	June 1- June 30	Annual Observance
Hispanic Heritage Month	September 15- October 15	Biennial Rotation
Disability Employment Awareness Month	October 1- October 31	Biennial Rotation
Native American Heritage Month	November 1- November 30	Biennial Rotation



#### Staff Recommendation Summary

Receive staff report and provide direction to staff to establish a calendar of ceremonial flag observances using one of staff's proposed options (or via other direction not contemplated by staff):

1. Adopt a comprehensive ceremonial flag display calendar that **rotates five ceremonial flag observances each year** and would advise staff of which five would be honored in each respective calendar year.

Or

2. Adopt a comprehensive ceremonial flag display calendar of five observances that includes annual ceremonial flag observance of Black History Month and LGBTQ+ Pride Month while rotating observances remaining observances through the remaining three authorized ceremonial flag observances.
