**ORAL COMMUNICATIONS** Julie Gilson, representing the Fremont Cultural Arts Council,

spoke on an initiative titled *Fremont Creates* and on Fremont's inaugural celebration of *Arts Culture and Creativity Month* for April 2023. A kick-off event is planned for Saturday, April 1, 2023 from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Downtown Event Center, which will showcase a variety of artists, cultures, and provide some community participation. ### **PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS**

Item 1. **BOXART!** ART SELECTION – To consider and select artwork for the boxART! program; and to consider an exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule, which states that, where it can be seen with certainty that the activity will not have a significant effect on the environment, that activity is not subject to CEQA.

**Senior Planner Mark Hungerford** introduced the item and reported on the recent call for artists that ran from early December 2022 through the end of January 2023, in which

36 student and 19 vinyl-wrap art submissions were received. He also brought special attention to a Notes and Corrections document (attached) that included a late submission under the vinyl-wrap category. Mr. Hungerford stated that the vinyl-wrap submissions were less than anticipated and recommended that the Board lift the restricted number of student awards to be granted in order to select a total of 30 from the box*ART*! submissions during this phase. Alternatively, if the Board selects fewer than 30, it was recommended that a limited call for artists be done to satisfy the balance of the remaining awards in order to affect a total of 40 traffic boxes for the current fiscal year, and to more fully utilize the expenditure that was granted for the program.

### Chairperson Meerjans opened the public hearing.

**box***ART!* **Program Manager Susan Longini** commented on the student submissions and the theme of sustainability, as well as the general locations of traffic signal boxes to be painted. Ms. Longini also offered for the Boards consideration, traffic signal boxes that are partially blocked from view that are not currently part of the inventory for box*ART!* artwork.

### **Chairperson Meerjans** closed the public hearing.

Following review and deliberation of the box*ART!* submissions, **Board Member Benton** moved to approve 19 student and 11 digital artwork submissions for a total of 30 box*ART!* awards. **Chairperson Meerjans** seconded.




Front Elevation View
