#### 5. SCHEDULED ITEMS

A. Mayor Harrison opened consideration of a Public Hearing (Published Notice) to Consider Staff and Planning Commission Recommendations for Amendments to Fremont Municipal Code Title 8 (Health and Safety), Chapter 8.55 (Smoking), and Title 18 (Planning and Zoning), Chapters 18.25 (Definitions), 18.43 (City Center Districts), 18.45 (Commercial Districts), 18.47 (Downtown Districts), 18.49 (Warm Springs Innovation District) and 18.190 (Special Provisions Applying to Miscellaneous Uses), to Regulate the Retail Sales of Electronic Cigarettes, and the Establishment and Operation of Electronic Cigarette Lounges and Vapor Bars, and to Consider an Exemption from the Requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) in that the Proposed Amendments are not a Project which has the Potential for Causing a Significant Effect on the Environment. (Regulation of Electronic Cigarette Retailers and Retail Tobacco Stores (including Electronic Cigarette Lounges and Vapor Bars) – Citywide – PLN2016-00119)

Senior Planner Wayland Li gave a have a PowerPoint presentation and responded to questions from Councilmembers, along with Deputy City Attorney Bronwen Lacey and Planning Manager Kristie Wheeler. Mayor Harrison opened the public hearing.

Jamie Caron (representing Disability Action Network for Youth), Dolores Tejada (representing Community Resources for Independent Living (CRIL), Bryan Kuo, Alexander Huynh, Nilabjo Chakraborty, Amrutha Prakasha, Ei Ei Phyo, Dania Khan, Sabeel Mansuri, Mary Wang, Donovan Seymour, Lenette Abad, Ray Mangrobang, and Elsa Joseph (all representing the Tri City Health Center Youth Advisory Board), and Paul Cummings (representing Alameda County Public Health Departement support the amendments to the Smoking Ordinance. There were no additional speakers. Mayor Harrison closed the public hearing. Councilmembers provided comment.

On a motion by Vice Mayor Mei, seconded by Councilmember Bacon, the City Council:

- 1. Held public hearing.
- 2. Found that this project is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines in that it is not a project which has the potential to cause a significant effect on the environment.
- 3. Adopted the Planning Commission recommendation with findings 4a and 4b and introduction of ordinance No. 2:
  - a. Found that the proposed Zoning Text Amendment is consistent with the City's General Plan, including Land Use Policy 2-2.5, which encourages using zoning regulations to improve Fremont's quality of life, reduce nuisances, achieve compatibility between adjacent uses, and protect the health and safety of residents, visitors, and workers. The proposed Zoning Text Amendment is intended to protect the health and safety of residents, visitors, and workers by establishing land use regulations that would preclude the establishment of retail tobacco stores (including those containing e-cigarette lounges or vapor bars).
  - b. Found that the proposed amendment furthers the public interest, convenience, and general welfare of the city because it would preclude the establishment of new retail tobacco stores (including those containing e-cigarette lounges or vapor bars), thereby reducing exposure of population to smoke and vapors and by reducing unlawful sales to minors.
  - c. Introduced an ordinance amending the Smoking Ordinance and Zoning Ordinance.
