

California's Accountability and Improvement System

- The Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) significantly changed how California provides resources to public schools
- Holds school districts accountable for improving student performance
- Passed 2013, includes state priority areas that define a quality education
- No longer based on a single test (API)
- Based on multiple measures: graduation rates, student test scores, suspension rates, etc.



MKV Differentiated Assistance Plan

- Legal training for administrators: W hat does and does not constitute a suspendable offense
- Illuminate training on Homeless Tile and other Illuminate resources
- Monthly suspension reports to Principals
- Examine suspension data and identify trends (student sub groups, areas on campus, classrooms, time of day, etc.)
- Sites with red, orange suspension rates: develop SMARTe goals in SPSA
- Generate list of interventions (other means of correction) in lieu of suspension



MKV Differentiated Assistance Plan

- Homeless students receive a customized class schedule
- COST team monitors Homeless students
- School mentor check-ins
- 8th Grade transition session with school counselor to develop 5 year plan
 - High school + post secondary
- Increase access to hygiene: washer/dryer, personal hygiene
