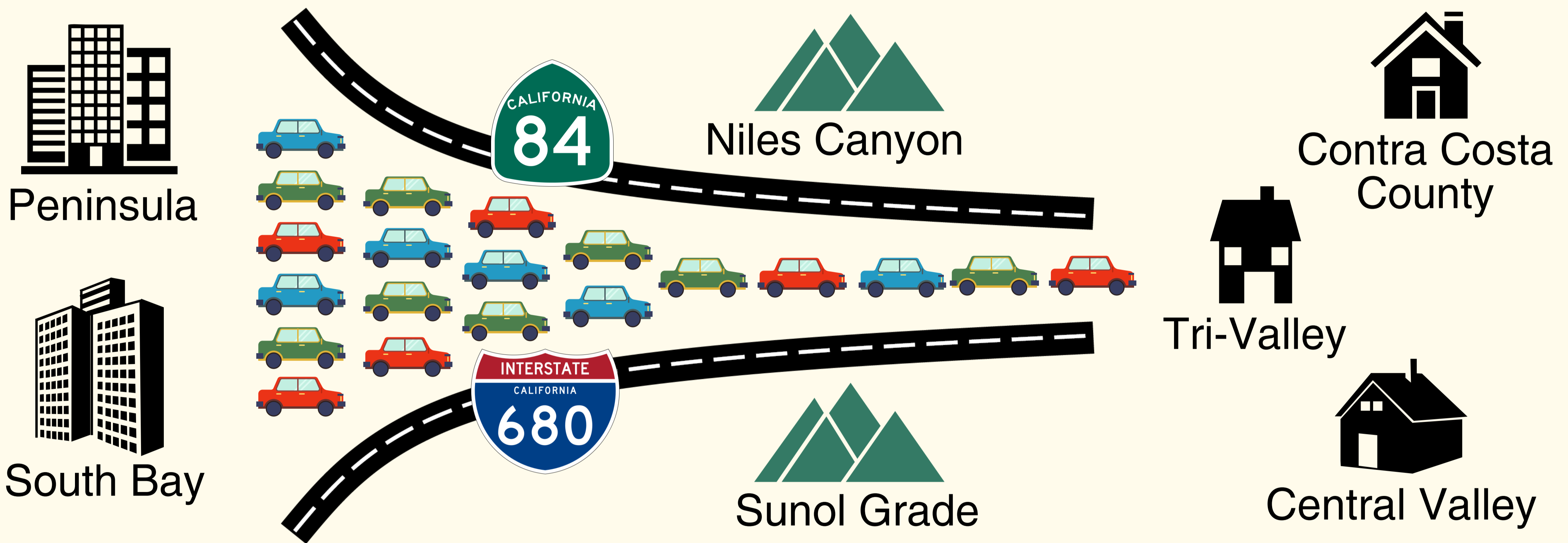

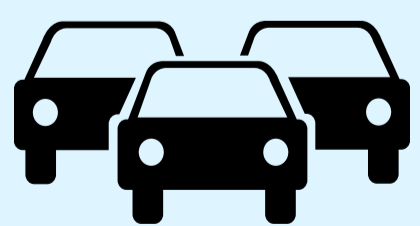
## FREMONT FUNNEL EFFECT: EVENING COMMUTE



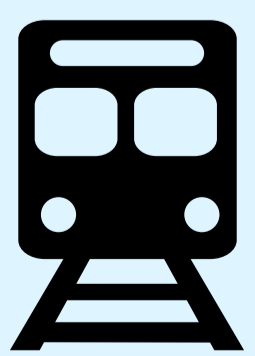

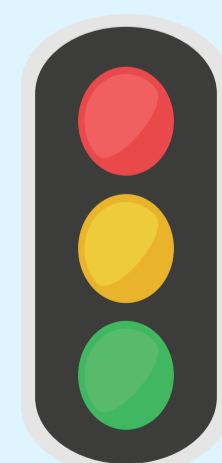
