Methodology

- Telephone survey of 602 randomly-selected City of Fremont residents.
 - Interviews were conducted October 10-20, 2013 via landlines and cell phones.
 - Interviews were conducted in English, Spanish, Mandarin, Pashto, and Dari.
- The margin of sampling error is +/-4.0% at the 95% confidence level
 - Margins of error for population subgroups will be higher.
 - Some percentages do not sum to 100% due to rounding.
- Select comparisons to prior 2012 and 2006 surveys.

Key Findings


- In general, residents especially Indian/Pakistani residents are more optimistic about life in Fremont than they were in 2012.
- Fewer are concerned about the City's budget and the local economy, and satisfaction with many City services has slightly increased.
- Strong majorities continue to see Fremont's diversity as an asset, feel safe in the City, and view it as a great place for families and seniors.
- However, majorities still see housing costs (56%) and freeway traffic (56%) as "extremely" or "very" serious problems in Fremont.
- Public safety particularly police protection are again top priorities.
- Most feel positive about the rate and kind of development in Fremont, though many would like to see more entertainment options and nightlife.
- Majorities of voters would conceptually support a one-half cent sales tax or a 4% Utility User Tax, though fewer feel that additional revenue is needed to provide City services at desired levels.



Life in Fremont


Over four in five Fremont residents rate the quality of life in the City as "good" or "excellent" – a notable improvement from 2012.

How would you rate the City of Fremont as a place to live: is it an excellent place to live, a good place to live, just average, poor, or an extremely poor place to live?




These positive impressions are shared by residents of all ethnic backgrounds, particularly Indian/Pakistani residents.

Rating Fremont as a Place to Live by Ethnicity




7. How would you rate the City of Fremont as a place to live: is it an excellent place to live, a good place to live, just average, poor, or an extremely poor place to live?

Residents are more optimistic about where Fremont is headed, as well as their own neighborhoods.




6. Would you say that things in **The City of Fremont/Your Local Neighborhood** have been moving in the right direction, in the wrong direction, or have not changed much over the last two years?

When people first move to Fremont, they are generally welcomed into the community.



How Long Have You Lived In Fremont?








While all ethnic groups agree Fremont is seniorfriendly, a quarter of white residents disagree.




Majorities of all ethnic groups agree feel Fremont's diversity is an asset.







Residents see the cost of housing and freeway traffic as top local concerns.















Do you think the rate of growth and development in Fremont is too fast, about right, or too slow?







Though most residents are favorable towards Fremont's development approach, some white residents are less enthusiastic.




Asian residents are more enthusiastic about the Downtown plan than White and Latino residents.




Residents are satisfied with most retail opportunities, although significant minorities are dissatisfied with entertainment and fine dining in Fremont.






How would you rate the overall job being done by Fremont city government in providing services to the City's residents?

Impressions of government openness and accountability have marginally improved.


How confident are you that Fremont City government operates in a way that is open and accountable to the public?



Assessing City Services


- Survey respondents were provided with a list of City services.

Residents see public safety – particularly police protection – as a top priority.





Bike lanes and involvement in City government are comparatively less important.





Satisfaction levels are particularly high for public safety and garbage/recycling services.









Satisfaction with public safety services has increased slightly...









There's little change in how residents view opportunities to get involved locally.












Three-quarters of residents continue to feel that local property values will be hurt if public safety services are reduced.

Local property values will be hurt if City public safety and maintenance services are reduced.




Residents are most likely to get news about City government from television news.

Other information sources are rarely only used.





Half feel the City is doing a "good" or "fair" job managing its budget...


How would you rate the overall job the City of Fremont does managing its budget?

How would you rate the overall job the City of Fremont does managing its budget?




Would you say that to maintain essential services, the City of Fremont has a great need for additional funding, some need, a little need, or no real need for additional funding?


Conceptual Support for a Finance Measure


- Survey respondents were asked about a conceptual finance measure.
- Half were asked about a one-half cent sales tax and half about a 4% Utility Users Tax (UUT).

Next, suppose there were a measure on the City of Fremont ballot to maintain and protect the level of essential services – including police, fire, street and park maintenance, and youth and senior services – currently provided by the City, and to restore a number of services that have recently been cut by (enacting a one-half cent sales tax)/(establishing a four percent utility users tax.)


If there were an election today, do you think you would vote "yes" in favor of this measure or "no" to oppose it?

A larger majority of voters would support a half-cent sales tax rather than a UUT measure.






However, less than half of voters believe the City cannot provide services adequately without further funding.

Conclusions

Conclusions

- There appear to be few areas where residents feel the City needs major course corrections – they generally feel that things are going well and improving.
- However, residents do see housing costs and freeway traffic as notable problems, and to a much lesser extent street maintenance and the lack of nightlife/entertainment.
- These positive feelings about the local economy and City government contribute to a somewhat diminished perception that the City is in need of additional revenue to adequately provide services.
- Consequently, while voters express conceptual support for a finance measure, they may not feel a strong sense of urgency to increase local taxes.
